Āryabhaṭa Ganit Challenge 2019

Guidelines for conduct of First Stage

- 1. The co-ordinator of this challenge will download the question paper, answer keys and the excel sheet (Mark Award Sheet for entering the marks of the students in the first stage).
- 2. Both Question paper and answer keys **must be kept confidential by the co-ordinator** and should not be shared with any other person **even after conclusion of the first stage**.
- 3. First stage will be a pen paper test. After conducting the test, the question paper with the answers may be collected back and evaluated as per answer keys and the papers should not be returned to the students till 25th November 2019.
- 4. After evaluation, the marks may be entered in the excel sheet (Mark Award Sheet) downloaded and may be uploaded through the link after completing the entries. No other excel sheet can be uploaded. No correction in the name of the students is allowed. In case of any mistake in the entries of marks, corrected file can be again uploaded , which will replace the original file.
- 5. If there is a tie at the top, another screening test may be taken by the school. Questions may be developed by the school for this test.
- 6. Top three students may be identified altogether irrespective of the classes in which they are studying and same may be marked in the system after uploading the Mark Award sheet.
- 7. After marking the toppers in the system, make a payment of **Rs.900/- (total for three students)** for the second stage. It is mandatory to identify top three students for second stage.
- 8. The details of the second stage will be available on **28**th **November 2019** (a day before the second stage of the challenge) in the system and can be accessed only by the schools registered for second stage by payment of fees.
